1. In order to partake of the fullness of Christ we need to come into the full counsel of God's Word and rightly understand the distinctions between the Old Covenant and the New Covenant

Questions:

1. Do you truly desire to come to the table Wisdom has prepared and how is this demonstrated moment by moment before your Father in heaven?

2. Are you seeking the full counsel of God's Word and how is this demonstrated in your devotion?

3. What possible misconceptions could you have in light of what has been presented that might cause you to be dispossessed of the full inheritance in Christ Jesus?

4. Do you know the difference between scripture being presented as milk or as meat and how does this relate to prophetic vision?

5. Do you know how to go about rightly dividing the Word of Truth and how it will reflect in your every day devotion and attitude of heart?

Prayer Points:

1. Father I thank you that You have prepared a Feast in Christ Who has become Wisdom for me, and I ask that You help me to understand this table and enjoy all that You have prepared

2. I thank You Father that You would help me to understand the full counsel of Your Word; and to understand the distinctions of the Old Covenant and the New and the difference between the letter of the law and the Spirit

3. Father I thank You that You would put a desire for the pure milk of Your Word in my heart that I may grow thereby, and that I would be able to understand the meat of Your Word, and come to an understanding of prophetic vision

4. I thank You Father that You would help me to rightly divide the Word of Truth, and that the Word would divide my soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and discern the thoughts an intent of my heart
